

# Good vibrations from Goscor

Construction equipment supplier Goscor Power Products is shaking up the market with the addition of a purpose designed and built vibratory plate compactor (VPC) to its wide range of light construction products.

**BECAUSE THE NATURE** of their work puts great strain on VPCs, Goscor's new vibrator is built extra strong to last the distance. The machine, dubbed TKP-90, is powered by a tough petrol-driven Robin-Subaru 5HP engine that comes with a five year warranty.

The TKP-90 compliments the already tried and trusted 9HP TKP-110 vibrator. As its model number implies, the new machine weighs in at just 90 kg even though it has an extra thick steel base plate for long-lasting operational life.

"This machine has been designed and built to be user-friendly," says Goscor Power Products' (GPP) national sales manager Mark Bester. "It has been equipped with a lifting hook and a wheel kit can be supplied for easy transport," he explains.

"The TKP-90 vibrates at up to 5 200 r/m and thus effectively removes air from soil up to 25 cm below the surface," adds Bester. "It can also be used for paving compaction applications.

"With a travel speed of up to 23 m/min and a grade ability of 23°, this machine can enhance efficiency and productivity greatly." Goscor has been supplying equipment to the light construction industry for the past 25 years dur-
