As with all GPP's Subaru engines, the

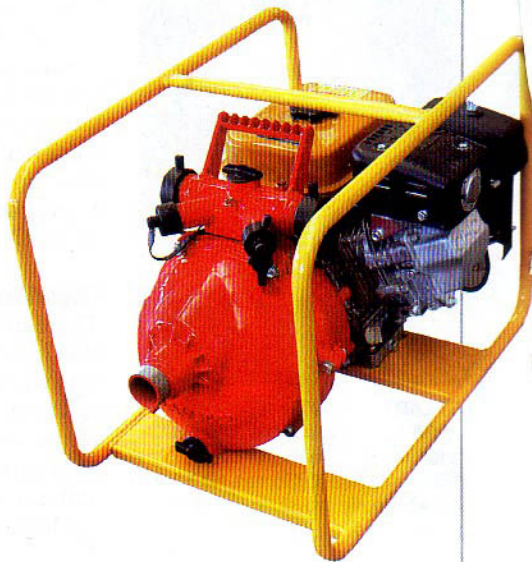
