



FIRE-FIGHTING EQUIPMENT

Range expanded

Goscor Power Products reports that it has expanded its fire-fighting equipment range and reduced its prices by up to 20%. "Excellent demand for our firefighters has enabled us to buy more competitively through increased bulk purchases and we are passing this advantage on to our customers," Mark Bester, general manager of Goscor Power Products, states.

The company's new range includes an entry-level, low-pressure unit, as well as a medium-pressure unit designed specifically for forestry applications and a high-pressure unit. Driven by a 5 hp Subaru EY side valve engine, the entry-level low-pressure unit is suitable for a wide range of applications. The medium-pressure unit, which is powered by a 6 hp and 7 hp Subaru overhead cam (OHC) engine with Davey pump, is available in single-stage and two-stage models. And the high-pressure unit is powered by a 5 hp and 6 hp Subaru OHC engine with a high-pressure Ruby pump capable of 22 ℓ /minute to 40 ℓ /minute at 35 bar. This unit is suitable for driving two hose reels.

Importantly, the OHC engines have fewer parts which equates to less wear and tear and diminished possibility of failure. In addition, there is less noise and vibration. The hose reel incorporates a newly designed ratchet system which prevents excess run-on of hose, Bester adds.
