Good lighting saves Soccer City

According to Henk Ferreira, MD of Global Events Management, cleaning up Soccer City after the 2010 FIFA World Cup opening ceremony presented a challenge; bearing in mind that the stadium had to be ready to host its second game soon afterwards. "Time was our greatest challenge," notes Greg Venter, operations manager for Goscor Rental which assisted with the task at hand.

Venter says that, if the concourses were not as well lit as they were to enable the company to work 24 hours, the job would not have been completed. The company says that it used two sweeper/scrubbers which were capable of vacuuming, sweeping and

scrubbing the concourses at the same time, and a Green Machine sweeper for the surrounding areas.

The M30 Tennant and M20 Tennant sweeper/scrubbers were used on the concourses. According to Venter, these



machines coped with the load and proved to be efficient, reliable and comfortable enough for drivers to operate for extended periods.
